The recipient must demonstrate financial need, be a citizen of the United States or of a country of the Western Hemisphere who intends to return to his or her native country, enroll in a minimum of twelve college credit hours and maintain a 2.5 grade point average or better on a four-point scale. A graduate school recipient must enroll in a minimum of nine graduate college credit hours and maintain a 2.5 grade point average or better. The following documents should be submitted: 1. Application Form; 2. Essay; 3. Letter of Recommendation; 4. Academic Transcript; and 5. Resume.
